Requirements

- This bursary is available to black South African learners as defined in the B-BBEE Act (i.e. African, Coloured, Indian or Chinese learners) that are **South African citizens** by birth or descent, with a valid SA ID number
- Applicant to be enrolled in 2022 for 4th year BBusSc with a major in Information Systems or BCom Honours in information Systems
- Should be interested in a career in consulting
- University academic average of at **least 60%** in 2nd and 3rd year
- Matriculation results to include a minimum grade of level 4 for English First Language or level 5 for English Second Language
- Must be enrolled for full-time study in 2022
- Must have intrinsic **analytical ability** and a love for problem solving

Selection process

1. Complete & submit the application form online - you will need to submit supporting documentation. A 1500 word essay will be required.

2. Applications will be assessed & shortlisted candidates will be contacted for a 1st interview

3. 2nd round interviews will take place with shortlisted candidates

4. An offer will be made to selected candidates by mid-September.

5. Bursary contract issued & signed by the end of September
